

Audience Guidelines For Our Outdoor Performances on Monday, May 31, 2021

The lawn area in front of the stage will have two sections: ground/blanket seating only and lawn chair seating (bring your own). There is also seating on the embankment. These areas will be marked by signage.

1. All tripods, umbrellas, tents, and other obstructions will not be allowed (our stage is at ground level and everyone should be allowed as unobstructed a view as possible).
2. Social distancing between family groups and mask wearing is required at all times.
3. Please note that this is an outside event on an open lawn - there are no special accommodations or assigned seating of any kind.
4. This is a sports field with a game scheduled in the evening so we ask that you be vigilant about not leaving any trash of any kind on the grass.
5. We understand that no one will have a perfect view. However, if we are mindful of leaving open space, are courteous and respectful of people who may be seated behind us, we can all enjoy this collective event which your children are working hard to present.
6. All audience members must be invited guests of the Griffith Academy community and wearing a wristband and a mask.
7. If you are videotaping your child's dance on your phone, please be mindful of others around you.
8. Any audience member who needs to use the restroom, will be asked to walk to the front of the Irish American Home and use the bathrooms inside the glass doors. **No adults allowed inside the downstairs area of the building for any reason, as dancers will be changing.**
9. Remember your sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat.

Dancer/Parent Drop-off/Pick-up Instructions

1. No one will be allowed to enter the Field before 11am and 1:30pm respectively. We will be building a stage! All dancers should be brought to the Backstage Mom holding a sign with your child's first dance written on it. Backstage Moms will be in the middle of the field behind the stage.
2. There will be a designated "Changing area" off to Stage Left for parents who wish to change their dancers. Please do not change your dancer in the Audience area. Dancers capable of changing themselves, may use the marked area inside the building. This area will only be used for changing and not for hanging out. No Parents inside. Dancers will return to the field once they are changed.

3. We will have “Quick change tents” behind the stage. We will speak to the dancers who need to use this area in the upcoming weeks.
4. When your child finishes performing, they can stay with their class and the Backstage Mom in our designated “Dancers Watching Area” off to Stage Right. They might enjoy watching the rest of the show with their classmates. At the end of the show, we ask that one parent collect him/her from this area. However, if you choose to go and get your child after their dance, we ask that you be aware of not disrupting others around you.
